

Know your race director

Doug Hazel- Bibra Lake Run by Joan Pellier

Doug was born in Manchester, UK and is married with two boys, 14 and 17, and came to Australia in 1983. Doug has always been keen on running and was a schoolboy champion and represented his county in the 10,000-metre steeplechase. On leaving school, he ran for Stratford Athletic Club in the UK league. Later as a member of East Cheshire Harriers one of his best runs was a 10 miler in Barrow in Furness which he ran in 52 minutes. Nic Rose and Brendan Foster were also in the race. He has done a 2.36 marathon and held the clubs RRC fastest time of 3.46 min per km for many years. Doug's running was curtailed after being injured at work (as a postie) when he fell off his motorbike after the front wheel locked in the rain causing him to do the splits damaging his pubic bone (Ouch, makes your eyes water!). Since then he seems to be more injury prone. Doug says his good lung capacity comes from his mothers' family who were Scottish sprint champions. No longer able to run, Doug is learning to ballroom dance and enjoys playing the piano, his favourite food is lasagne, favourite TV The Bill, favourite movie A Wonderful Life and as for the Vets, he thinks we should advertise

ourselves more.

RESULTS

Bassendean Run 19/9/99
