Treasurers Report 2023/24

I present the annual accounts to members and am pleased to report a solid year with no occurrences to disrupt the committee's goal of a break-even result.

The 2024 result was solid. I can report a surplus of \$2359 for the year.

Cash on hand as a result remains extremely healthy and sits at \$86715.

Revenue

Revenue continues to be strong as a result of a strong membership base.

Visitor numbers were steady.

Membership as at 30 June was 651.

As a result of the Reserve Banks 13 interest rate rises our 2 term deposits benefited as we earned interest of \$2808.

Expenses

State Championships returned a small deficit of \$1317 but was as a result of improved amenities which made for a better experience for both competitors and spectators alike.

Also to celebrate our 50th anniversary a function at East Fremantle Yacht Club was held at a cost of \$2456

There were no other large items of expenditure of note and any replacement equipment was of minimal cost.

Clothing

2024 saw the full implementation of a new supplier with the additional benefit of the club no longer paying for stock held.

Events

Due to a steady decline in attendance the social weekends away are no longer a part of our annual calendar.
